

The Haunted Tunnel Road Rally!!!

Saturday, October 24, 2009

Get in the spirit of Halloween and join us on this beautiful fall road rally where we visit the longest Covered Bridge in the U.S. and one very spooky looking train tunnel! This is the season of the Druids, be afraid, be very afraid!



WHO: The road rally is open to all street legal vehicles. 50 vehicles maximum.

ENTRY FEE: \$35 per vehicle pre-registered, \$45 day of the rally.

WHEN: Saturday, October 24, 2009. Rain or shine.

WHERE: The rally begins and ends at the Skyline Drive Picnic Shelter in Jackson-Washington State Forest. Take U.S. Route 50 to Brownstown and head east on State Route 250. Travel 1.7 miles on State Route 250 and turn right onto 100E. Travel 2/10 of a mile and turn right onto Skyline Drive. Travel 1.0 mile and turn right into the Skyline Drive Picnic Shelter parking lot.

TIME: Registration begins at 9:00 am. Tech meeting is 9:45 am. Rally begins at 10:00 am sharp.

COURSE: Approximate length: 79 miles. Will take about 5 hours to complete. 3 pit stops. The "Haunted Tunnel" Scenic Road Rally is our all time classic road tour featuring some very interesting and beautiful sites in south central Indiana. Some of the highlights include: The longest Covered Bridge in the United States! It measures 434 feet in length and is over 100 feet longer than a football field! **Several spectacular ridge views** are included on the tour, one know locally as the "Devils Backbone." For the more daring participants in our group, we'll stop and take a wild walk across a swinging foot bridge or climb a fire tower! During the day we'll pass through a half dozen little towns that time has forgotten and visit a railroad tunnel that no one can forget! This tunnel was built during the 1850's and is over 1/4 of a mile long. Local legend has it that in the 1800's a man was beheaded and his body was hidden in the tunnel. **To this day, local residents report sightings of a man walking in the tunnel carrying his head!**

WHAT TO BRING: You must be at least 18 years old to be a driver, possess a valid drivers license, bring proof of automobile insurance. Drivers license and insurance card must be current. Vehicle registration will not be accepted. Bring a clip board, a pen or pencil, a shoe box for your scavenger hunt items, bottled water, a full tank of gas, at least one or more navigators and a garlic necklace...**Vampires** tend to be a problem during this time of year. Prizes will be awarded to the top winning teams after the Road Rally. **No alcoholic beverages, no pets and no hot rodding permitted.** Consuming an alcoholic beverage before, during or after the rally at the park will result in immediate disqualification and no refund.

We will also need 1 "Support Team" (2 people) to help score after the rally. In return for your help, your entry fee will be waived and you will receive a 30 minute head start on the rest of the pack. WHAT IS A ROAD RALLY?

A road rally is a driving tour in the country, on well paved public roads where a group of people compete in a very casual outing for points to win prizes.

As each team leaves the "gate" they receive a "Rally Packet" which includes directions, scavenger hunt list, and tour questions. Five points are awarded for each scavenger hunt item collected and five points are awarded for each question answered correctly. The team with the highest score wins. We have at least 3 pit stops scheduled for this road rally. A "Pit Stop" is a pre-designated stop where you can get out of your vehicle, stretch your legs and take a bathroom break.

This road rally is designed and conducted by Scenic Road Rallies LLC of Sunman, Indiana. Our road rallies are in no way, shape or form, a race! The rallies are family oriented with no alcohol permitted before, during or after the event. We strive to take the contestants on the roads least traveled and we'll definitely take you to places that most people don't even know about.
